Bumpers Drive-In & Western Sizzlin Award Another \$37,000 in College Scholarships to Mississippi High School Seniors as Part of Essay Contests Canton (MS) ... Thirty-seven thousand dollars in college scholarships was recently awarded by Bumpers Drive-In/Western Sizzlin through two statewide essay programs.

The primary program, known as the Bumpers Drive-In/Western Sizzlin Essay Contest, was open to any Mississippi high school senior enrolled in an accredited public or private school, located in a community with a local Bumpers Drive-In or Western Sizzlin restaurant. To enter, students simply needed to submit a typed one-page essay explaining, "Why I deserve a \$1,000 Scholarship from Bumpers Drive-In and Western Sizzlin." One \$1,000 scholarship was awarded to a senior at every school from which a minimum of 10 essays were received. Winners were selected solely on the strength of submitted essays

Bird Dog Foundation Essay Contest
